The admission committee of the college hereby directs all the desirous candidates to register for Provisional Admission(offline) prior to the formal online admission. *Candidates are advised to formalize their admission in respective colleges on a provisional basis till 12th class result is declared.*

Following the Registration, the students may contact the college for Counseling till their result is declared. NEP 2020 will be introduced. Therefore, counseling in colleges will be available for any assistance or advice with regard to choosing of courses as there will be no distinction between streams like Arts, Science and Commerce. Please feel free to contact the college on any working days.

### Eligibility:

- 1 Candidate should have a Provisional Admission record.
- 2 Students opting for Mathematics as a Foundation Course (Major) subject should have Mathematics in Higher Secondary.
- 3 Students opting for Life Science as Foundation Course (Major) should have Botany or Zoology or allied Science in Higher Secondary.
- 4 Students opting for Physical and Chemical Science as Foundation Course (Major) should have Physics or Chemistry or allied subjects in Higher Secondary.
- 5 The choice of courses will be for both 1st and 2nd Semester.
- 6 Choice of Generic courses should be different from Core and Minor courses.

**Note:** Each college will reserve 10% of the intake capacity for candidates outside their catchment area.

Each section will have multiple of 80 and 120 students for Practical and Non-practical subjects respectively, depending upon the human resources and infrastructural facilities of the college. Allotment of colleges and admission and choice of courses will be based on merit to be determined on the basis of the marks obtained by a candidate in the Qualifying Examination.

## Eligibility

For admission in the UG Course, the candidates must have passed the 12<sup>th</sup> examination in all subjects from a recognized board. Candidates having passed their 12th examinations from boards other than JK BOSE have to submit a migration certificate at the time of admission.

## Admission Procedure:

Admission to the UG course will start after 15 days from the declaration of the 12<sup>th</sup> class Examination. The entire process of admission is online, thus making the admission procedure user-friendly, transparent and hassle-free. - T colored recent passport photograph-03 and a file cover.
- **Gap Affidavit:** Candidates having a gap of more than one year have to submit an affidavit or undertaking duly attested by 1<sup>st</sup> class magistrate regarding his/her code of conduct and unemployment.
