




Fun GAMES- The Department of Sports, GDC Kargil, conducted a set of fun games in the playground of the campus. The students of the college and different schools participated in the program.


## TROUT FISH FARM, DAMSNA PANIKHAR KARGIL

Kargil, October 10, 2023. The Department of Geology at Government Degree College (GDC). Kargil organised a one-day field visit to the Drans Valley, located in the Kargil district of Ladakh, to provide HSc 3xl semester students with an immersive experience in the region's fuscinating geological landscape.

Draws Valley is renowned for its diverse and striking genlogical features, making it an ideal location for geological studies and prospecting. During the visit, students had the opportunity to closely examine various rock formations and study the stratigraphic sequence that characterises the region.






