The purpose of the educational tour was to explore entrepreneurial opportunities regarding small business units like fish farm, poultry farm and other small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in the district. Also to broaden the knowledge of the students and provide real-world exposure to the subjects they study in our curriculum. It will complement their classroom learning and allow them to connect theory with practical experience.



At the Fish Farm, students were enlightened by the incharge of the fish farm in detail regarding the environment of the site, what could be the total capital requirement of establishing the fish farm, how much infrastructure is required, how much manpower is required, what is the source of water, whether perennial source is required or we may have non-perennial (stored water) for proper rearing of fish.



Also the students asked questions and cleared their doubts and queries from the farm incharge. They also visited various compartments of the fish farm like the breeding section, rearing section, etc.



THULUS PURTSE KARGIL-LADAKH




