An Overview

Govt. Degree College Kargil (Ladakh) is established in 1995 and was inaugurated by Retd. Gen.K.V. Krishna Rao, the then Governor of J & k state and has got affiliated with Kashmir University. Since then, it become one of the notable and glorious seats of higher academic learning of Kargil, Ladakh. It is located at Bagh-e Khomeini –the extreme western part of Khurbathang plateau, some 500 feet above the Kargil town. The location of the college and the surroundings provide a very congenial and tranquil atmosphere for academic pursuit.

At present, the college has beautifully architectural buildings which include an administrative block (consisting of Principal chamber, clerical section, and



staff chamber) Commerce and Geology block, main lecturer block (with a capacity of 100-120 students), science block (consisting of chemistry, Zoology, botany and physics laboratories with a capacity of 35-40 students) and a Canteen.

Recently some other structures like library block and biochemistry Department were raised. Two hostels for Girls, each Under PNDP and tribal affairs are under construction and are at the verge of their completion. The college has four student busses in the college transport. The college stands included by UGC under 2(f) and 12(B) on 17th of March 2005 and the college is accredited by NAAC with B Grade.

Eligibility

Admission in UG Course, the candidates must have passed the 12th examination in all subjects from a recognized board. Candidates who passed 12th class examinations other than JK BOSE have to submit a migration certificate at the time of admission.

Admission Procedure:

Admission to the UG course will start after 15 days from the declaration of the 12th class Examination. The entire process of admission is online, thus making the admission procedure user-friendly, transparent and hassle-free. To start the process of online admission, the student has to log on to Ladakh University Website

<https://www.universityofladakh.org.in> and click “Apply” After completing the registration on the Ladakh university website, the candidate has to fill out subject combination form on Govt. Degree College Kargil website <https://kargilcollege.net> after submitting the combination form take a printout and submit the forms in the college Kargil with all requisite documents and admission fee.

Certificates and Documents to be submitted

Following certificates and documents to be submitted along with the printed registration form in the college.

- Two photocopies of 10th and 12 class marksheets
- Two photocopies of ST
- Original leaving/provisional certificate.
- Two copies of the character certificate.
- Migration certificate if the student has passed part-II higher secondary examination from a board other than JKBOSE.
- Three no. of colored recent passport photograph and a file cover.
- **Gap Affidavit:** Candidates having a gap of more than one year have to submit an

affidavit or undertaking duly attested by 1st class magistrate regarding his/her code of conduct and unemployment.

Code of Conduct

- Every student must come to college in proper uniform.
